This letter is in response to your request regarding the waste generated from using the GreenEarth dry cleaning agent. I reviewed the manufacturer's safety data sheet you provided for the dry cleaning agent. It appears that waste generated from the use of this product would not be hazardous as long as no other chemicals or detergents are used in the dry cleaning process.

However, Missouri hazardous waste regulations require the generator of a waste to determine whether a waste is hazardous. This determination can be based on laboratory testing or by knowledge of the process generating the waste. If you have any questions please contact me 1-800-361-4827.
